February 2 – 22, 2012

(Departs Calgary evening of Feb 2nd)

Vietnam is the eastern most country in the Indochina Peninsula. With a population of over 89 million, it is the 13th most populous country in the World. Emerging from the various prolonged military conflicts, Vietnam instituted political and economic reforms resulting in economic growth being one of the highest in the world in the past decade. This has resulted in numerous investments in the tourism infrastructure. Part of these developments are the numerous high quality golf courses that have recently been opened, such as Montgomerie Links, and The Dunes Course by Greg Norman. Siem Reap is the most popular tourist destination in Cambodia because of the World Heritage Site designation of Angkor Wat. But to the surprise of many, there are two spectacular golf courses that have just recently opened. Critics have said that given time to mature, these two courses will be among the top courses in Asia.

- Feb. 2-4** Depart Calgary in the late evening for our flights to Hanoi via Vancouver with arrival into Hanoi in the evening. After clearing airport formalities, we transfer to our hotel, [Hanoi Nikko Hotel](#).
- Feb. 5** Hanoi is one of the oldest and most charming cities in Asia with its traditional Vietnamese architecture and the French Quarter with French colonial villas and broad boulevards lined with sandalwood trees and coffee houses. Today's full day tour of Hanoi will visit Ngoc Son Temple inside Lake Hoan Kiem, Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, One-Pillared Pagoda, the History Museum, the Temple of Literature, and the old quarter. - Feb. 6** Our first round of golf this morning is at [King's Island Golf Resort](#). This evening we enjoy a Water Puppet Show followed by dinner at Minh Anh Restaurant. Meals: B,D
- Feb. 7** Our second round of this is at **Phoenix Golf Resort**. Meals: B
- Non Golfer* : A full day tour to Halong Bay in Vietnam's Gulf of Tonkin. You will board a junk and sail along the bay amongst the 2,000 limestone islands of varying sizes rising among its emerald water. You will also visit the Dau Go cave and Thien Cung Cave. Meals: Lunch on board
- Feb. 8** This morning we fly to Danang. A tour of Danang with stops at China Beach, the Cham Museum as well as the local town. After lunch, proceed to our resort in Hoi An, [Le Belhamy Hoi An Resort](#). Meals: B,L
- Feb. 9** Morning round of golf at **The Dunes Course**, a Greg Norman designed course. Meals: B
- Feb. 10** Full day tour of Hoi An, a World Heritage Site, with its history of a trading post of seafaring Chinese, Japanese and Portuguese merchants several centuries ago. Meals: B,L

Feb. 11	Morning round of golf at The Montgomerie Links , voted the best golf course in Vietnam.	Meals: B
	<i>Non Golfer:</i> A full day tour of Hue, the ancient capital of Vietnam. You will visit the Imperial Citadel and its Royal Enclosure, the Forbidden Purple city. Then enjoy a boat ride up the Perfume River to Thien Mu, an ancient Buddhist temple. Lunch will be served at the Tinh Gia Vien, the best vegetarian restaurant in town. Visit Khai Dinh Royal tomb in the afternoon.	Meals: B,L
Feb. 12	A free day to relax on the beach.	Meals: B
Feb. 13	Transfer to Danang airport for flight to Ho Chi Minh City with arrival transfer to Majestic Hotel Saigon .	Meals: B
Feb. 14	Morning tour of Ho Chi Minh City, visiting War Remnants Museum, Notre Dame Cathedral, the Municipal Post Office. In the afternoon, visit Cu Chi Tunnels, famed for its 200-km. long underground tunnel system used by the guerrillas in the past two wars.	Meals: B,L
Feb. 15	Morning round of golf at Vietnam Golf & Country Club a 36-hole course that is regarded as the premier golf course in Vietnam.	Meals: B
Feb. 16	Morning round of golf at Song Be Golf Club . This 27 hole course is the first international standard championship golf course in Vietnam and known as one of the most challenging in the country.	Meals: B
Feb. 17	A full day Mekong Delta trip. Start the trip with a visit to My Tho, a town on the side of the Mekong River and two hour drive from Saigon. Cruise via sampan along the river through small islets and observe the daily activities of the local people. After, a visit to an orchard to observe the different agricultural activities of the area. Feb. 18	Transfer to airport for flight to Siem Reap, Cambodia. After clearing airport formalities, transfer to our hotel, Angkor Palace Resort & Spa . Afternoon program: visit to the World Heritage of Angkor Wat Temple ; study both the splendid architecture and bas-relief until late evening transfer to Re Rup temple where is an excellent place for countryside view during sunset.	Meals: B,L
Feb. 19	This morning we visit the wonderful temple tour to visit the lost city of the Khmer Empire: by taking elephant ride from South Gate of Angkor Thom to famous Bayon temple then walking up to visit giant faces of famous Bayon and Baphuon temples, terraces of Elephants and Leper King and the unforgettable jungle temple of Ta Prohm. After lunch, we visit some of the more remote Angkor sites such as a cute pink stone of Banteay Srei temple and visit the nearby landmine museum and on the way back to Siem Reap town stop to visit Pradak village to see lifestyle of local people and handicraft procedures. Feb. 20	Morning round of golf at Angkor Golf Resort designed by European legendary golfer Nick Faldo.	Meals: B
	<i>Non Golfer:</i> A 2-hr Spa Treatment at the resort for today.	Meals: B
Feb. 21	Morning round of golf at Phokeethra Country Golf Club <i>Non Golfers:</i> This morning visit floating and fishing villages in Tonle Sap	Meals: B

Great Lake, which one of the world's most productive bodies of fresh water. Each year, millions of fish come to spawn in the seasonally flooded forest surrounding the lake, attracting myriad water birds as well as people, who have settled in villages along the shores and who live with the rhythms of the water. This ecosystem of extraordinary biological richness and balance between humans and nature was recently designated as a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO. Back to town to visit Artisans D'Angkor (wood and stone carving) where you will discover the traditional Khmer techniques used for stone and wood carving and shopping before transferring to your hotel before noon.

Feb. 22 This morning transfer to airport for flights home.
