### *DISCOVER BALI – SIGHTSEEING & GOLF TOUR*

January 8 – 27, 2010



If you stop just for a second, and think of the word 'BALI', an image will flash in your mind's eye... Maybe it's a deep red sunset, the silhouette of a volcano or verdant terraced rice paddies. It might just be the perfect wave, the serenity of meditation or an ice cold Bintang Beer! Bali has something different for everyone who visits her, and never fails to impress even the seasoned traveler. Bali, a tropical island in the Indonesian archipelago, is so picturesque and immaculate it could almost be a painted backdrop. It has rice paddies tripping down hillsides like giant steps, volcanoes soaring up through the clouds, dense tropical jungle, long sandy beaches, warm blue water, crashing surf and a friendly people who don't just have a culture but actually live it

Jan. 8/9 – Depart Calgary in the late evening for our flights to Bali via Vancouver & Taipei.

Jan. 10 – Arrive into Denpasar international airport in the afternoon and after clearing airport formalities, we transfer to **Le Meridien Nirwana Golf & Spa Resort** ([http://www.starwoodhotels.com/lemeridien/search/hotel\\_detail.html?propertyID=1836](http://www.starwoodhotels.com/lemeridien/search/hotel_detail.html?propertyID=1836))

Jan. 11 – Our first round of golf at our resort’s **Nirwana Bali Golf Club** (<http://www.nirwanabaligolf.com/english/welcome.html>) Designed by the legendary Greg Norman, this course is one of the most photographed and challenging golf courses in the world. With three holes running along the cliffs of the Indian ocean and terraced rice paddies providing unique hazards, the course will test the accuracy and consistency of a PGA Professional and still be enjoyable for the average golfer.  
**Non Golfers:** A 3-hour spa treatment is scheduled for you ( B )

Jan. 12 – Second round of golf at Nirwana Bali Golf Club  
**Non Golfers:** A 3-hour spa treatment is scheduled for you ( B )

Jan. 13 – Free day ( B )

Jan. 14 – Morning departure for the **Bali Handara Kosaido Golf Club** (<http://www.balihandarakosaido.com/profile/index.html>).



After lunch, our tour starts at Bedugul Market for Fruits, vegetable, and spices, and then visit Ulun Danu Beratan lake Temple. This Ulun Danu temple is dedicated to the goddess of serene lake Bratan. Located on a lake that fills the crater of ancient mount Bratan in Tabanan area, in the northwestern part of Bali, in an elevation of 1239



meter above sea level. When the mist of the mountain floating away with the wind, the temple with it's multi-tiered towers appear and reflected by the lake.

**Non Golfers:** You will be transferred later in the morning to the golf club for lunch with the group followed by the tour. ( B,L )

Jan. 15 – Another round of golf at Bali Handara Kosaido Golf Club. ( B )

Jan. 16 – Free day ( B )

Jan. 17 - Transfer to Denpasar airport for your domestic flight to Labuan Bajo in West Flores Island. In Labuan Bajo, you will be welcomed and met by local staff with direct transfer to Bajo Harbour to catch a boat for our journey to Rinca island. Lunch will be provided. Arrive at Rinca Island after a 2 hour boat trip and proceed with a hike to see activities of the Komodo dragons. In this island, besides the dragons you can also other wild animals such as deer, horses, birds etc, in their wild life. Continue to Kalong island, where during the sunset, in this Kalong island (Kalong = Bat) we could see hundreds of bats, if not thousands, migrating out of the island to start their night looking for food. Dinner served onboard while sailing back to Labuan Bajo. Arrive Labuan Bajo transfer to **Bintang Flores Hotel** (<http://www.bintangfloreshotel.com/>). ( B,L,D )



- Jan. 18 - After breakfast, short city sightseeing to visit the old stone fossil at Mirror Cave and also local market will also be made before transferred to the airport for your flight to Denpasar. On your arrival in Bali, transfer to the **Bali Hyatt** (<http://bali.resort.hyatt.com/hyatt/hotels/index.jsp>) ( B )
- Jan. 19 – Free day ( B )
- Jan. 20 – Morning round of golf at **Bali Golf & Country Club** (<http://www.baligolfandcountryclub.com/golf.html> ) voted "One of Asia's 5 Best Golf Courses" (Fortune Magazine - USA)  
**Non Golfers:** A tour of the capital of Bali, Denpasar. This tour starts with a visit to the Museum Negeri, giving you an insight into the history of Bali. Then visit the Pasar Burung or “bird market” followed by visit to the Government Art Centre, home to some of the island’s most treasured works ( B )
- Jan. 21 – Morning round of golf at Bali Golf & Country Club  
**Non Golfers:** A visit to Pura Luhur Uluwatu, one of the regions most celebrated temple, perched 250 ft. above the water. Continue on to the fishing village and powdery white sands of Tanjung Bena before returning to hotel. ( B )
- Jan. 22 – Free day ( B )
- Jan. 23 – This morning we travel to the village of Batubulan for a rendition of the famous Barong Dance. This famous performance is an exotic favourite, depicting the combat between the evil witch Rangda and the Barong. The followers of the Barong become entranced and display their invulnerability through stabbing themselves repeatedly with their sharp, wavy Balinese daggers. Though charged with emotion, the dancers remain unscathed. Next lunch at Kintamani and enjoy the views of the Volcano Mt. Batur and its stunning crater lake. After lunch take in breathtaking rice paddy vistas, the water palace of Tampaksiring and the Elephant Cave at Bedulu. ( B,L )
- Jan. 24 – Today we visit to town of Ubud, known as the centre of Balinese Arts & Crafts. You will get a chance to stroll along the town and visit the various local shops featuring local artists at work. Visit the mask makers and woodcarvers at Mas Village, and the silver and goldsmiths at Celuk Village ( B,L )
- Jan. 25 – Morning round of golf at the **New Kuta Golf Club** (<http://www.newkutagolf.com/> ). Carved out of harsh limestone and edged between the brilliant white limestone cliffs and the endless blue horizon of the Indian Ocean, this course ranks among Asia’s best and most challenging. ( B )

Jan. 26 – Final round of golf at the New Kuta Golf Club. Evening group farewell dinner. ( B,D )

Jan. 27 – Afternoon transfer to airport for our flights home via Taipei & Vancouver. ( B )
