Golf in the wild of the tropical rainforest. It has been described as Asia's Best Kept Secret. Sabah & Sarawak are the destinations in Borneo for history, mystery, romance and exotic golf adventures. The land of the fabled White Rajahs, the hornbill and the orang utan. Its rainforest, the size of Austria, houses the world's richest and most diverse ecosystem. Its variety of golf courses range from a course built around swampland to remote mountain hideaway located atop a jungle-clad plateau.

Day 01 & 02 (Sat/Sun) Depart Calgary/Edmonton in the evening for flights to Kota Kinabalu via Vancouver & HongKong with **Cathay Pacific Airways**.

Day 03 (Mon.) Arrive into Kota Kinabalu in the morning. After clearing airport formalities, transfer to **Hyatt Regency Kinabalu** (<http://kinabalu.regency.hyatt.com/hyatt/hotels/index.jsp>) Balance of day free to get caught up with jet lag or to explore the area around your hotel.

Day 04 (Tue.) This morning drive through rural countryside to a Bajau fishing village built over the water. Walk along gangplanks to explore the village. Visit a native market at Tuaran, try out a suspension bridge before visiting a local pottery workshop. This evening visit the night markets and feel the heartbeat of KK as you mingle with local people. Drive by some of Kota Kinabalu landmarks before adjourning for dinner. Enjoy an array of native dances while savouring delicious Malaysian cuisine. Meals: B, D

Day 05 (Wed.) Morning round of golf at the **Dalit Bay Golf & Country Club** (<http://www.shangri-la.com/kotakinabalu/rasaria/countryclub/en/index.aspx>). Designed by Ted Parslow, this course has a course rating of 72 and slope of 130 from the blue tees. Meal : B

Day 06 (Thu.) Morning round of golf at **Sutera Harbour Golf Club** (www.suteraharbour.com/v2/golfclub), 27-holes of championship, Graham Marsh designed holes and provides a golfing challenge for both intermediate and seasoned golfers. Voted Malaysia's Best Golf Resort at the 2006 World Travel Awards and Best Golf Resort at Hospitality Asia's 2005 Platinum Awards. Meal: B

Day 07 (Fri.) Free Day Meal: B

- Day 08 (Sat.) Full day tour to visit the Lok Kawi zoological park and spend the morning exploring the various animals and birds found in the park such as **Orang Utan, Bears, Borneo pigmy Elephants, Tigers, Sumatran Rhinoceros, Hornbills**. Enjoy a local lunch before proceeding to the little town of Weston and a short boat ride to the lodge. Proceed on an hour trek in the mangroves for a closer view of this unique forest. In the early evening go on a boat cruise through mangrove forest to see Proboscis Monkeys, long & short tail macaque monkeys and other forms of wildlife and birds. Common sights are monitor lizards and the occasional crocodile. During the boat ride, see hundreds of fireflies twinkling in the mangrove trees making them look like Christmas trees. Meals: B,L,D
- Day 09 (Sun.) Free day Meal: B
- Day 10 (Mon.) Morning round of golf at **Nexus Karambunai Golf Club** (www.karambunai.com/index.html). This Ronald Fream designed course, the site of the Malaysian Amateur Open 2007, is nestled between a typical Borneo jungle on one side and the South China sea on the other. Meal: B
- Day 11 (Tue.) Morning round of golf at **Borneo Golf & Country Club**. Meal: B
- Day 12 (Wed.) Transfer to airport for flight to Kuching with arrival transfer **Riverside Majestic Hotel** (www.riversidemajestic.com/rmh).
- Day 13 (Thu.) Morning tour of Kuching, one of the few cities left in Southeast Asia that will remind you of old Asia! Visit Gambler spice streets with their open air markets, Main Bazaar for bargain shopping, India streets, Carpenter streets, Sarawak Museum, Malay Village, Muslim mosque, the oldest Chinese Temple in Sarawak, Kuching Waterfront, Civic Centre. Afternoon free for you to explore the city on your own or visit the Kuching weekend market. Meals: B
- Day 14 (Fri.) Check out of Kuching hotel and proceed to **Borneo Highlands Resort** (www.borneohighlands.com.my), home of the spectacular **Hornbill Golf & Jungle Club**, built on top of a tropical rainforest and our home and golf venue for the next three days. First round of golf this morning. Meals: B,L,D
- Day 15 (Sat.) Second round of golf at the challenging **Hornbill Golf Club**. Participate in one the resort's guided Nature walk around the rainforest followed by a massage treatment at the Resort. Meals: B,L,D
- Day 16 (Sun.) Another round of golf at the challenging **Hornbill Golf Club** this morning. After lunch, check out of resort and proceed back to Kuching with accommodations at **Majestic Riverside Hotel**. Meals: B,L
- Day 17 (Mon.) Morning free. Afternoon transfer to airport for flights home via Kota Kinabalu & Hong Kong, arriving into Calgary/Edmonton in the late evening Meals: B
