February 05 – 22, 2010

Feb. 05 - CALGARY - DUBAI

Depart Calgary around lunch time for Dubai via Toronto.

Feb. 06 – DUBAI

Arrival into Dubai in the evening with transfer to **Faimont Dubai** (<http://www.fairmont.com/dubai/>)

Feb. 07 – DUBAI

(B)

Our first round of golf today is at **Dubai Creek Golf Club** (www.dubaigolf.com/dcgye/), voted one of the world's 'Top 100 Must-Play Golf Courses'. 8:40AM tee time

Feb. 08 – DUBAI

(B, L)

Our day's tour of Dubai begins with a visit to Jumeirah Mosque, and proceed toward Bastakia where old-time wind tower houses of wealthy merchants greet you. Next is the Dubai Museum, a treasure house of historical relics. Further, a stroll through the flashy textile market, and a happy ride across the creek in the local Abra (water taxi). This brings us to the heady aroma of the spice market and the dazzling Gold Souq. Lunch at **Atlantis Hotel**, Kaleidoscope Restaurant

Feb. 09 – DUBAI

Today's golf is scheduled at **Emirates Golf Club** (Wadi course by Faldo / www.dubaigolf.com/egc) host of the PGA European Tour sanctioned Dubai Desert Classic and Dubai Ladies Masters. 8:35AM tee time

Feb. 10 – DUBAI

(B)

Today's golf is scheduled at **Emirates Golf Club** (The Majlis Course / www.dubaigolf.info/emiratesgolfclub/emiratesgolf.html) The original home of the Dubai Desert Classic and the flagship course of Emirates Golf Club, The Majlis Championship course is a challenging par 72, 7200-yard course. Sculptured around the original tall desert dunes in 1987, The Majlis was the first grass course in the Middle East and takes its name from the Arabic for 'meeting place'. Indeed, one of the most prominent features on the course is the Majlis building itself, positioned between the 8th and 9th holes.

Feb. 11 – DUBAI

(B, L)

Today's tour explores the lovely capital of UAE, **Abu Dhabi**. From Dubai, you drive past Jebel Ali Port – one of the finest man-made ports and Jebel Ali Free Zone. Abu Dhabi is the abode of the Ruling family and a Centre of oil business. Here you visit the yards of the grand Al Husn palace. At the Abu Dhabi Corniche, admire the placid waters kissing the horizon, offering a breathtaking view of the city skyline. Further on, take a look at traditional 'tali' handwork at the local Craft Centre. Finally, visit the Dhow yard, where traditional boats are built using a method that is centuries old.

Feb. 12 – DUBAI**(B, D)**

This morning's round of golf will be at **The Montgomerie** (www.themontgomerie.com/) As the name implies, this championship golf course was designed by Colin Montgomerie in association with Desmond Muirhead. The course covers 265 acres which consist of 123 acres of turf, 49 acres of man-made lakes (a total of 14 lakes), 93 acres of landscaped gardens and is scattered with 81 large bunkers. 8:20AM tee time. This afternoon we drive across the desert of Dubai with several photo-stops during an exciting dune drive to the first destination a camel farm. The drive continues across the desert. We stop to watch the beautiful sunset before reaching our campsite where you have the opportunity to do a camel ride, sand boarding and try out a henna design on hand or feet. After working up an appetite enjoy a delicious barbecue dinner while enjoying the entertainment of a belly dancer performing her show around the campfire by starlight.

Feb. 13 – DUBAI / CAIRO**(B,D)**

Transfer to airport this morning for flight to Cairo with arrival transfer to the **Sheraton Cairo Hotel** (www.starwoodhotels.com/sheraton/property/overview/index.html?propertyID=386). This afternoon we visit the Egyptian Museum. This evening we enjoy a typical Egyptian dinner.

Feb. 14 – CAIRO**(B, L)**

Our full day tour starts with visits to the Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx. After lunch, visit the Citadel, the Alabaster Mosque, Old Cairo Coptic Churches and the Cave Church

Feb. 15 – CAIRO**(B)**

This morning we golf at the JW Marriot Mirage Golf Club. Afternoon free to explore Cairo.

Feb. 16 – CAIRO – LUXOR**(B,)**

Morning flight to Luxor with arrival transfer to **The Maritim Jolie Ville Resort** (http://www.jolieville-hotels.com/luxor_welcome.php). Afternoon tour of the East Bank visiting Karnak Temple and the Luxor Temple.

Feb. 17 – LUXOR**(B,L)**

Morning tour of the West Bank visiting the Valley of the Kings, Valley of the Queens, and the Necropolis of Thebes. Lunch. Afternoon free to relax in the resort

Feb. 18 – LUXOR**(B)**

Our final round of golf in Egypt this morning at the Royal Valley Golf Club.

Feb. 19 – LUXOR – DUBAI**(B)**

Early morning transfer to airport for our flights to Dubai via Cairo with accommodations in Dubai at the **Dusit Thani Dubai**

Feb. 20 – DUBAI**(B)**

This morning round of golf at **The Els Club Dubai** (www.elsclubdubai.com) an Ernie Els designed course. 9:00AM tee time

Feb. 21 – DUBAI**(B,D)**

Final round of golf at **The Emirates Golf Club** (Faldo Course) 9:00AM tee time. Evening group farewell dinner

Feb.22 – DUBAI – CANADA**(B)**

Morning flight home via Toronto.
