PHILIPPINES GOLF TOUR – Deluxe Program

- Jan. 21 & 22 – Depart Calgary in the late evening for your flights to Manila via Vancouver & Hong Kong.
- Jan. 23 – Arrive into Manila in the late morning with arrival transfer to the **Sofitel Philippine Plaza** (www.sofitel.com/gb/hotel-6308-sofitel-philippine-plaza-manila/index.shtml). After check-in, enjoy the spectacular lunch buffet. (L)
- Jan. 24 - Full day tour of Manila that brings you to the well-selected historical landmarks and interesting parts of the city: Rizal Park, the country's premier park and the site of many important events in the country's history; Intramuros, the Spanish colonial city. Historical landmarks include Fort Santiago, the old Spanish military headquarters; San Agustin Church, the oldest stone church in the city which has a museum of religious and secular art. A horse drawn "Calesa" ride through Chinatown will allow you to observe close up the lifestyle of this community. Finally, we take you to the most modern part of the metropolis, Makati - the country's financial and commercial hub followed by visit to the War Memorial. After lunch, we visit a typical rural town called Tagaytay wherein we get a chance to visit a typical jeepney factory. As well, you will see the spectacular view of Taal Volcano within Taal Lake. Non Golfers: Take an exhilarating trip to the idyllic town of Angono in the eastern part of Metro Manila. Nestled between the hills of Antipolo and the famous Laguna de Bay, this town's claim to fame is its being home to many famous visual artists. On this tour you will have the rare opportunity to visit the Angono Caves where ancient petroglyphs dating back to circa 3000 B.C. was discovered. A cultural heritage site, this pre-historic Filipino work of art offers an evocative glimpse into the life of ancient Filipinos. Lunch will be served at the Nemiranda Art and Café

- Jan. 28 – Morning flight to Boracay Island with arrival transfer to the **Discovery Shores Resort** (Junior Suite / www.discoveryshoresboracay.com/home.php). Balance of day free (B)
- Jan. 29 – Free day to relax and enjoy the spectacular fine white powder beach. (B)
- Jan. 30 – Morning round of golf at **Fairways & Bluewater Golf Club** (B)
- Jan. 31 - Morning round of golf at **Fairways & Bluewater Golf Club** (B)
- Feb. 01 – Free day (B)
- Feb. 02 – Morning flight to Cebu City followed by transfer to the **Maribago Bluewater Beach Resort** (Amuma Spa Suites / www.bluewater.com.ph/maribago/home.php) (B)

Feb. 03 - Full day tour of Cebu City & Mactan. Relive history as you visit the oldest city in the Philippines. Visit Fort San Pedro, Magellan's Cross-, the oldest street in the Philippines, which is Colon Street and the famous Carbon Market where goods are sold at lowest price. Appreciate Cebu's rich culture, creatively assimilating foreign influences with local folk sensibilities, as seen in old churches like the Basilica Minore and Majestic Taoist Temple. Enjoy scenic beauty driving through hilly residential areas and colorful gardens of Beverly Hills. Then proceed to Mactan and visit the island/s famous church "Virgin of the rule" (Birhen sa Reglo). From this point you will be taken to Abuno, the lace very famous for guitar factory. Last stop will either be at the shopping mall or handicraft store. (B,L)

Feb 04 – Morning round of golf at **Alta Vista Golf Club**. Afternoon free (B)
Non Golfer: Full day tour to Bohol Island. A beautiful showcase of history, culture and nature in one destination. This tour brings you to the historic Blood Compact Shrine, a historical landmark commemorating the 1st Treaty of Friendship between the east and the west, before visiting the centuries-old Baclayon Church & Museum. Enroute to the Chocolate Hills, you drive through the lush Mahogany Man-Made Forest and the green farmlands in Bilar and Batuan. In Bilar visit a Butterfly Farm which showcases a variety of Phil butterfly species. View the awesome cone-shaped hills known as the Chocolate Hills from a viewing deck on top of one of these hills. Drive back to Loboc for a 50-minute river cruise along nipa-lined river on board a native catamaran. A sumptuous barbecue lunch is served on board. The river cruise will surely relax both your body and mind as you view nature's beauty of rolling hills, graceful coconut trees and green nipa-palms lining the riverbanks. (B,L)

Feb 05 – Morning round of golf at **Club Filipino Golf Club**. Afternoon free. (B)

Feb. 06 – Transfer to airport for flights home via Hong Kong & Vancouver. (B)
